



SummerFest@Wan Chai: Sports Playground

Disc Golf, Cycling, Trampoline, Football, Basketball, Golf and Bowling All-you-can-play





(Hong Kong, June 16, 2025) The annual SummerFest@Wan Chai features the Sports Playground this summer holiday as its regular program from now until September 28 at the Wan Chai Harbourfront Event Space, with seven interactive and energetic games: disc golf, cycling, trampoline, football, basketball, golf, and bowling, as well as two creative photo areas, all providing a dynamic summer carnival atmosphere for local families and tourists alike.

Additionally, a total of 25 special pop-up program events related to culture, music, dance, and athletics, will be held during this period, showcasing the wide-ranging appeal of the Wan Chai Harbourfront Event Space. Conveniently located by the waterfront promenade, the Wan Chai Harbourfront Event Space spans approximately 13,300 sq. m., making it Hong Kong's exciting new landmark for large-scale events, all located just a few minutes' walk from the MTR Exhibition Centre Station and Wan Chai Pier.

In addition to the Sports Playground, SummerFest@Wan Chai will co-host special programs with a wide range of organizations on the selected weekends, public holidays and weekdays, including energetic sports events such as: Baseball5 Dynamic Happy Hour, "BA Cup" Baseball5 Flash Game – 1st Hong Kong High Five Baseball5 Championship Pre-event 1.0, Smart Ping Pong Challenge Station, Summer Dodgeball Splash, Hong Kong Balance Bike Championship Session 14, JC Fit City – Street





Challenge, Cycling Lap and Points Race - Wan Chai, SunLight Balance Bike Cup and Invitational Race - Wan Chai, Cycling Obstacle Race - Wan Chai, and The Artistic Sport Day.

There will also be various engaging music shows, including *Tseung Kwan O Joint-School Busking, Little Singer Summer Recital, FAME Student Performance, Maestro Art Summer Concert, Summer Jams: Family Music Fest 2025, All Star Academy Dream Come True 2025, Let's Aim High Charity Music Showcase, and Afternoon Melodies: The Tale of Cantonese Music.* Exciting dance performances like *FJDC K-pop Dance Showcase* and *Sway of Summer* are also highly anticipated. Captivating cultural programs include: "Arts to Hearts" Expressive Arts for Mind-Body-Spirit Wellness Cultural Festival – "HOME" Expressive Arts Workshops and Collective Artwork Creation (Exhibit in Osaka EXPO), Expressive Arts for Mind-Body-Spirit Wellness Cultural Festival – "Calling" Sunset Concert, and "Taste of Sri Lanka 2025" Food Carnival, allowing everyone to appreciate the value of proper mental health and the diversity of world cultures.

Sports Playground - Regular Program of SummerFest@Wan Chai


1) Disc Dash disc golf game Spin a frisbee gracefully in the air straight into the target area; it's a fascinating and easy game.





2) Circle Run cycling game

Get on the bicycle with a maximum of 5 participants to make the entire bicycle ring spin together. The riders may experience the fun of building a team rhythm.



Jump and dash through inflatable obstacles for an exclusive bouncy summer adventure.





4) Battle Field football game

Players split into two teams try to kick a ball into the opponent's target area under the table.

5) Summer Hit Zone golf game

Take a mighty swing and send the golf ball to the target to experience the thrill of summer's ultimate sports challenge.









6) Rolling Alley bowling game

Play the bowling you know but do it in an outdoor environment.

7) Basket Shot basketball game Take a shot as soon as you get the ball and try to be the best shooters.





8) Panda Photo Zone

Stand next to the inflatable panda for great IG pictures; this popular photo spot is perfect for families and friends to capture great memories together.



Set against inventive photo setups that create unique perspectives, as well as a set of wide-angle mirrors, it allows participants to easily capture photos in their own personal style.
